

**CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE**

**BYLAW NO. 6954**

**A Bylaw to amend "City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993".**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to the authority granted to it under the Municipal Act, City Council has enacted "City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993" to regulate parking and traffic on highways in the City of Prince George and Off Street Parking for the physically disabled;

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed desirable to amend City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993 with regards to the placement of signage to identify designated disabled parking spaces;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993 be, and is, hereby amended as follows: Section 63., subsection 2., is deleted in its entirety and a new section 63., subsection 2., as follows, is substituted therefore:

63. 2. The public parking area owner is responsible for:

- a) The procurement, installation and maintenance of the authorized signs referred to in Section 62;
- b) Ensuring that the authorized signs are located so as to be seen by a person driving a vehicle;
- c) Ensuring that the authorized signs have a glare-free surface; and
- d) Ensuring that the authorized signs for parking spaces are 1.5 m above the ground measured to the bottom of the sign, and located as near to the front edge and centre of the designated parking stall as reasonably possible.

2. That the City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993 be, and is, hereby amended as follows: A new section 63., subsection 3., as follows, is added thereto:

63. 3. The authorized signs are to be in place prior to the issuance of an occupancy permit.

3. This bylaw may be cited as "City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993, Amendment Bylaw No. 6954, 1998.

READ A FIRST TIME THIS THE 7<sup>th</sup> DAY OF December, 1998.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE 7<sup>th</sup> DAY OF December, 1998.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 7<sup>th</sup> DAY OF December, 1998.

All three readings passed by a unanimous decision of Members of City Council present and eligible to vote.

ADOPTED THIS THE 14<sup>th</sup> DAY OF December, 1998, BY A UNANIMOUS DECISION OF ALL MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL PRESENT AND ELIGIBLE TO VOTE.
