

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7397

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to authorize the transfer of monies from the Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund to the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund, as per the year 2002 capital budget approved by Council.

WHEREAS, the Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund has been established by "Capital Expenditure Reserve Bylaw No. 6931, 1998";

AND WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund of \$7 082 942, which has been calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund has been established under section 496 of the Local Government Act by "Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 7179, 2000";

AND WHEREAS the Local Government Act provides that if the amount to the credit of a reserve fund is greater than required, the Council may, by bylaw, transfer all or part of the amount to another reserve fund;

AND WHEREAS the money to the credit of the Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund is greater than required, and \$550 000 was approved for transfer to the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund per the year 2002 capital budget;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

1. The sum of \$550 000 is hereby transferred from the Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund to the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund.
2. This bylaw may be cited as "Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund Transfer Bylaw No. 7397, 2002".

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE 8th DAY OF July, 2002.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 8th DAY OF July, 2002.

All three readings passed by a *unanimous* decision of Members of City Council present and eligible to vote.
