

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE
BYLAW NO. 8880

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to amend the City of Prince George Sign Bylaw No. 7202, 2001.

WHEREAS City of Prince George Sign Bylaw No. 7202, 2001 has been adopted to regulate signs;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to amend “City of Prince George Sign Bylaw No. 7202, 2001”;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. That “City of Prince George Sign Bylaw No. 7202, 2001” be, and is, hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) by deleting the definition of “Political Sign” from Section 4.1 in its entirety;
 - (b) by deleting the words “and Political Signs” from section 8.4.a.;
 - (c) by deleting section 9.1.f. in its entirety; and
 - (d) by adding the following paragraph to Section 10.1:


“10.1.i. Political Signs, including any Sign primarily intended to promote the activities or the cause of any political group or entity or to encourage or discourage any Person to vote in any manner at an election or public referendum, whether Federal, Provincial, Municipal or other and as regulated by “City of Prince George Election and Political Signs Bylaw No. 8867, 2017” as amended from time to time.”
2. The Mayor and Corporate Officer are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “City of Prince George Sign Bylaw No. 7202, 2001, Amendment Bylaw No. 8880, 2017”.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS 24th DAY OF JULY , 2017
