

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7681

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George authorizing the expenditure of monies from the Southwest Sector Recreation Facility Reserve Fund for capital projects as per the year 2004 capital budget approved by Council.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Southwest Sector Recreation Facility Reserve Fund established by "Southwest Sector Recreation Facility Reserve By-Law No. 4562, 1985" of \$298 905, which amount has been calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Bylaw No. 4562 for capital projects as per the year 2004 capital budget approved by Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of \$35 000 is hereby appropriated from the Southwest Sector Recreation Facility Reserve Fund to finance the following:

2. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Southwest Sector Recreation Facility Reserve Fund.
3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Southwest Sector Recreation Facility Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw No. 7681, 2004".


READ A FIRST TIME THIS THE 18TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2004.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE 18TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2004.


READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 18TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2004.
