## CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

## **BYLAW NO. 8080**

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to rezone certain lands and to amend the Prince George Zoning Bylaw No. 7850, 2007.

**WHEREAS** pursuant to the provisions of Section 903 of the Local Government Act, in relation to zoning, the Council of the City of Prince George is empowered to make regulations thereto;

AND WHEREAS Bylaw No. 7850 has been passed to make regulations thereto;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Prince George has deemed it desirable that certain lands be rezoned from P1: Parks and Recreation to RS2: Single Residential to allow for a single-family residential use, or other uses, pursuant to the RS2: Single Residential zoning designation;

- That the "City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No. 7850, 2007", be, and is, hereby amended as follows: Lot 53, District Lot 4050, Cariboo District, Plan 26344, is hereby rezoned from P1: Parks and Recreation to RS2: Single Residential, as shown outlined in heavy black line on the map attached to, and forming part of, this bylaw as Appendix "A".
- 2. That the Zoning Map referred to as Schedule "A" of the "City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No. 7850, 2007", shall be amended accordingly.
- 3. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
- 4. That this Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No. 7850, 2007, Amendment Bylaw No. 8080, 2007".
