

**CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE**

**BYLAW NO. 7678**

**A Bylaw of the City of Prince George authorizing the expenditure of monies from the Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure for capital projects as per the year 2004 capital budget approved by Council.**

**WHEREAS** there is an unappropriated balance in the Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure established by: "Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure Bylaw No. 6935, 1998" of \$4 392 296.

Balance in Reserve Fund at December 31, 2003 \$4 392 296

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Bylaw No. 6935 for capital projects as per the year 2004 capital budget approved by Council;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Prince George in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The sum of \$1 052 000 is hereby appropriated from the Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure to finance the following:

-Mainline Valve Replacement	50 000
-Municipal Infrastructure Man System (MIMS)	120 000
-New Well – Western Acres	80 000
-National Research Council (NRC) Participation Fee	15 000
-Plastic Service Replacement	200 000
-PW602 – Soft Starters	77 000
-PW605 – Chlorine Generation	139 000
-PW611 – Twinning	25 000
-PW816 Reservoir – Deactivation	30 000
-Watermain Looping – Bittner Road	75 000
-Watermain Loop Southridge/St.Patrick	75 000
-Watermain Non-Destructive Testing	50 000
-Well Protection Plans	35 000

Total \$1 052 000

2. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure.

3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure Bylaw No. 7678, 2004".
