

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE
BYLAW NO. 7861

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to amend City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993.

WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to amend the City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056 by adding, removing, and replacing wording in "Part 1 – Definitions and Interpretation", "Part 2 – Interpretation - General", "Part 9 – Maximum Parking Limit", and "Part 10 – Heavy Vehicle Parking";

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS WITH THE FOLLOWING:**

1. That the following definition be added to Section 1:

"Authorized Person" means the person appointed by Council as head of the Development Services Department, or a person designated in writing by the head of the Development Services Department to carry out any act or function under this bylaw.

2. That the definition of "**Director, Public Works**", in Section 1, be removed in its entirety.
3. That all references, in the bylaw to "**Director, Public Works**" be replaced with "**Authorized Person**".
4. That the definition of "**Municipal Decal**", in Section 1, be replaced with the following:

"Municipal Decal" is a licence plate issued pursuant with Part 20, Division 3, of the *Local Government Act*.

5. That a new Section "2.5" be added with the following:

2. 5. Interpretation of Maximum Parking Limits

In this Bylaw:

- a) Whenever a reference to a zone, pursuant to the City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No.7850, 2007, includes only the letters AG, AR, AF, RS, RT, RM, C, M, P, U, W or Z they shall be deemed to include all zones starting with those letters in combination with other numbers;
- b) Where a single parcel is located in more than on zone, pursuant to the City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No.7850, the maximum

parking limit provisions of this Bylaw shall be applied as if the zone boundary were a parcel boundary; and

- c) Where parcels with more than one zone abut either side of a highway, the maximum parking regulations shall be construed to affect the portion of the highway between the parcel boundary and the center-line of the highway.

6. That Section "9.4" be replaced with the following:

No person shall park a vehicle or permit a vehicle to remain parked on a highway abutting a parcel located in the following zones: AG, AF, AR, RS, RT, RM or Z9 of the City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No.7850, 2007, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. the same day, from October 15 to April 15

7. That Section "9.5" be replaced with the following:

No person shall park a vehicle or permit a vehicle to remain parked on the side of a highway abutting a parcel with an even civic address located in the following zones: AG, AF, AR, RS, RT, RM or Z9 of the City of Prince George Zoning Bylaw No.7850, 2007, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. the next day, from October 15 to April 15.

8. That Section "10" be replaced with the following:

No person shall park or permit to be parked a vehicle, semi-trailer, trailer, or combination thereof with a gross vehicle weight exceeding 5,500 kg, or a length in excess of 7.5 m, on a highway abutting a parcel located in the following zones: AG, RS, RT, RM, C4, C8, P1, P2, P5, W, Z2, Z7, or Z9, for a cumulative period longer than 3 hours during any one day.

9. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this bylaw.

10. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993, Amendment Bylaw No. 7861, 2007".


READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 2nd DAY OF APRIL , 2007.
