

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

Bylaw No. 6914

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to establish a special reserve fund for the purpose of providing for snow control costs.

WHEREAS the Council may establish, by bylaw, a special reserve fund for a specified purpose that is within the powers of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council wishes to establish a reserve fund for the purpose of providing for snow control costs;

AND WHEREAS snow control is a purpose that is within the powers of the municipality pursuant to the *Municipal Act*;

AND WHEREAS the electors have been given an opportunity to petition against this bylaw pursuant to the *Municipal Act*.

AND WHEREAS Council has not received a valid and sufficient counter petition;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) For the purposes of this bylaw, "snow control costs" means the costs incurred to clear snow from highways (including sidewalks and pathways) and apply sand, salt or other materials thereon, in order to make highways (and sidewalks and pathways) useable. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, it also includes associated costs such as hauling, treating and disposing of snow which has been removed from highways, sidewalks and pathways, removing accumulations of sand and grit from highways, sidewalks and pathways, repairing damage caused during the course of snow control operations, and maintaining appropriate crews and equipment in a state of readiness to deal with snow and/or ice conditions.
- 2) There is hereby established a special reserve fund, entitled the "Snow Control Costs Reserve", for the purpose of providing funds to pay for snow control costs.
- 3) Funds deposited in the reserve and interest earned thereon may be used only for the purpose of paying for snow control costs.
- 4) This bylaw may be cited as "Snow Control Special Reserve Bylaw No. 6914, 1998".

READ A FIRST TIME THIS THE 1st DAY OF June, 1998.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE 1st DAY OF June, 1998.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 1st DAY OF June, 1998.

All three readings passed by a unanimous decision of Members of City Council present and eligible to vote.

ADOPTED THIS THE 27th DAY OF July, 1998, BY A unanimous DECISION OF ALL MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL PRESENT AND ELIGIBLE TO VOTE.
