

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7760

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George authorizing the expenditure of monies from the Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure for capital projects as per the year 2005 capital budget approved by Council.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure established by "Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure Bylaw No. 6933, 1998" of \$3 978 070.

Balance in Reserve Fund at December 31, 2004 \$3 978 070

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Bylaw No. 6933 for capital projects as per the year 2005 capital budget approved by Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The sum of \$1 693 000 is hereby appropriated from the Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure to finance the following:

-Municipal Infrastructure Man System (MIMS)	\$60 000
-NRC Participation Fee	18 000
-Pre-Paving Upgrades - Sewer	100 000
-PW103 Upgrade Study	40 000
-PW116 Pump Replacement	28 000
-Sewer Lift Stations Capital Upgrade	222 000
-Western Acres Lagoon Upgrade	300 000
-WWTC Greenhouse	25 000
-WWTC Belt Filter Press Replacement	50 000
-WWTC Microturbine Installation	<u>850 000</u>

Total \$1 693 000

2. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure.
3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure Bylaw No. 7760, 2005".
