

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE
BYLAW NO. 7526

**A Bylaw to amend the City of Prince George Fetal Alcohol Syndrome
Warning Sign Bylaw No. 5705, 1991**

WHEREAS Council of the City of Prince George enacted "City of Prince George Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Warning Sign Bylaw No. 5705, 1991" to require signs to be posted warning patrons of licensed premises of the dangers posed to fetuses by consumption of alcohol by pregnant women;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend said Bylaw by changing the wording of the warning sign to have it linked to a community-oriented health focus and to include provisions to have signs placed in all liquor sales locations;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled,

1. That Section 1.(a) be amended as follows:

"Licensed Establishment" means a liquor sales location and any place or premises licensed under the provisions of the Liquor Control and Licensing Act and includes restaurants.

2. That Section 3.(b) be amended as follows:

For any licensed establishment which permits the consumption of alcoholic beverages on the premises, there shall be one sign conspicuously displayed in each public washroom located within the premises.

3. That Section 3.(d) be amended as follows:

Lettering on the sign shall be in bold print, white on a green background and shall be a minimum of 1 cm (3/8 in.) in height.

4. That Section 3.(e) be amended as follows:

**Healthy Communities
Support Women and Their Partners
To Avoid Alcohol
During Pregnancy**

5. That Appendix "A" be deleted and replaced in its entirety by Appendix "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
6. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
7. That this Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "City of Prince George Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Warning Sign Bylaw No. 5705, 1991, Amendment Bylaw No. 7526, 2003".

READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 6th DAY OF October 2003.
