

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7560

A Bylaw to amend the "City of Prince George Development Cost Charge Bylaw No. 6861, 1997" by removing the fees and charges therein and placing them in the Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw.

WHEREAS Council enacted "City of Prince George Development Cost Charge Bylaw No. 6861, 1997" to provide for the imposition of development cost charges;

AND WHEREAS Council wishes to amend Bylaw No. 6861, 1997, by removing the fees and charges schedule set out in the Bylaw and list them instead in the "City of Prince George Comprehensive Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 7557, 2004";


NOW THEREFORE, Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That "Schedule A" of "City of Prince George Development Cost Charge Bylaw No. 6861, 1997" is removed in its entirety and placed in the "City of Prince George Comprehensive Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 7557, 2004", listed as Schedule "A-4(a)".
2. Section 4.1 is hereby amended by removing the words "Schedule "A" attached to, and forming part of, this Bylaw." and replacing them with "Schedule "A-4(a)" of the "City of Prince George Comprehensive Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 7557, 2004"."
3. That Section 4.3 (a) and (b) are hereby amended by removing the words "Schedule "A" and replacing them with "Schedule "A-4(a)" of the "City of Prince George Comprehensive Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 7557, 2004"."
4. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
5. This Bylaw may be referred to for all purposes as "City of Prince George Development Cost Charge Bylaw No. 6861, 1997, Amendment Bylaw No. 7560, 2004."

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE 4th DAY OF October, 2004.
READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 4th DAY OF October, 2004.
