

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7636, 2004

A bylaw to enlarge the Core Water Service Specified Area.

WHEREAS by “Nechako, Airport and Core Water Service Specified Area Merger Bylaw No. 6512, 1996”, the Council merged certain existing specified areas to create the Core Water Service Specified Area for the continued provision of water service to the area;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it advisable to enlarge the Core Water Service Specified Area to include certain additional lands;

AND WHEREAS under the *Community Charter* the Council may enlarge the specified area;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to enlarge the specified area has been given in accordance with the *Community Charter*, and a petition sufficient to prevent Council from proceeding with adoption of this Bylaw was not received within thirty days of the aforementioned notice;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Core Water Service Specified Area is enlarged by including within the area the lands legally described as:
 - Lot 1, District Lot 7634, Cariboo District Plan BCP4772;
Block A (Plan B3724), District Lot 4051, Cariboo District
Except Plan 22731;
 - Lot 1 District Lot 4050 Cariboo District Plan 25854;
District Lot 4051, Cariboo District except: Firstly, Plan
B3724, Secondly, Plan 22731, Thirdly, Plan BCP4770;
 - Lot 2, District Lot 4051, Cariboo District Plan BCP4772;
Block A, District Lot 7634, Cariboo District Plan 1985,
Except Firstly: Plan 10401, Secondly, APLN BCP4772;
 - Lot A, District Lot 4052, Cariboo District Plan PGP39896;all of which lands are shown outlined in bold line on Schedule A, and the specified area as so enlarged shall be known as the “Core Water Local Service Area”.
2. The Core Water Local Service Area may be merged with other local service areas, whether contiguous or not, for the purpose of providing water service.
3. This bylaw may be cited as “Core Water Local Service Area Enlargement Bylaw No. 7636, 2004”.

READ A FIRST TIME THIS THE 27th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2004.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE 27th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2004.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 27th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2004.

All three readings passed by a *unanimous* decision of Members of City Council present and eligible to vote.

ADOPTED THIS THE 20th DAY OF DECEMBER, 2004
BY A *UNANIMOUS* DECISION OF ALL MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL
