#### **CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE**

#### **BYLAW NO. 7725**

A bylaw of the City of Prince George, enacted pursuant to the British Columbia Transit Act, authorizing the entering into an Annual Operating Agreement for Custom Transit Services.

WHEREAS the City of Prince George has been authorized to undertake a transit function pursuant to the British Columbia Transit Act, and British Columbia Transit (the Authority) has established a transit service area being an area including the whole of the City of Prince George;

AND WHEREAS the City of Prince George has entered into a Transit Service Agreement with the Authority;

AND WHEREAS the British Columbia Transit Act provides that where the Authority contracts for a custom transit service it shall negotiate with the Carefree Society, or its successor, and an affected municipality with a view to entering into an operating agreement respecting the provision of transit services;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. The City of Prince George is hereby authorized to enter into an Annual Operating Agreement with the Authority and the Carefree Society for Custom Transit Services. A copy of said Agreement is attached to, and forms part of, this Bylaw as Schedule "A".
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign said Agreement and affix the City Seal thereto and deliver the same as acts and deeds of the City of Prince George, and do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
- 3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Custom Transit Service Annual Operating Agreement Bylaw No. 7725, 2005".

# ANNUAL OPERATING AGREEMENT (CUSTOM TRANSIT)

**Among** 

THE CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

**BRITISH COLUMBIA TRANSIT** 

And

CAREFREE SOCIETY
(as agreed to in the MOA)

**APRIL 1, 2005 TO MARCH 31, 2006** 

INPORMATION CONTAINED IN THIS AGREEMENT IS BURJECT TO THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT. CONSULT WILLIEG TRANSIT PRIOR TO RELEASING IMPORMATION TO INDIVIDUALS OF COMPANIES OTHER THAN THOSE WHO ARE PARTS TO THIS AGREEMENT.

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#### ANNUAL OPERATING AGREEMENT

BETWEEN:

THE CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

(the "Municipality")

AND:

**BRITISH COLUMBIA TRANSIT** 

(the "Authority")

AND:

CAREFREE SOCIETY

(the "Operating Company")

WHEREAS the Municipality and the Authority are authorized to contract for the provision of a Public Passenger Transportation System and share in the costs of providing same pursuant to the British Columbia Transit Act.

WHEREAS the Operating Company is authorized to operate, manage and maintain a Public Passenger Transportation System within the Prince George Custom Transit Service Area.

WHEREAS the parties hereto have entered into a Master Operating Agreement effective which sets out the general rights and responsibilities of the parties hereto.

**AND WHEREAS** the parties hereto wish to enter into an Annual Operating Agreement which sets out, together with the Master Agreement, the specific terms and conditions for the operation of the Public Passenger Transportation System for the upcoming term.

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH that in consideration of the premises and of the covenants herein contained, the parties covenant and agree with each other as follows:

#### SECTION 1 - DEFINITION OF TERMS

1.1 <u>Definitions</u>: Unless agreed otherwise in the Annual Operating Agreement, the definitions set out in the Master Agreement shall apply to this Annual Operating Agreement including:

(a) "Annual Operating Agreement" shall mean this Annual Operating Agreement and any Annual Operating Agreement Amendment negotiated and entered into by the parties subsequent hereto:

(b) "Master Agreement" shall mean the Master Operating Agreement, including any amendments made thereto;

#### SECTION 2 - INCORPORATION OF MASTER AGREEMENT

2.1 Incorporation of Master Agreement into Annual Operating Agreement: Upon execution, this Annual Operating Agreement shall be deemed integrated into the Master Agreement and thereafter the Master Agreement and the current Annual Operating Agreement shall be read together as a single integrated document and shall be deemed to be the Annual Operating Agreement for the purposes of the British Columbia Transit Act, as amended from time to time.

#### **SECTION 3 -- TERM AND RENEWAL**

3.1 Term and Renewal: The term of this Agreement shall be from April 1, 2005 to March 31, 2006 except as otherwise provided herein. Pursuant to successful settlement between the Operating Company, the Municipality, and the Authority this Agreement will be renewed for one (1), twelve-month period. An option for one (1) twelve month extension may also be made upon the approval of BC Transit and the Municipality. It is acknowledged by the parties that in the event of termination or non-renewal of the Annual Operating Agreement, the Master Agreement shall likewise be so terminated or not renewed, as the case may be

#### **SECTION 4 – SCHEDULES**

- 4.1 <u>Schedules</u>: The schedules attached hereto shall form part of the Annual Operating Agreement and be binding upon the parties hereto as though they were incorporated into the body of this Agreement.
  - a) Schedule "A" Transit Service Area
  - b) Schedule "B" Service Specifications
  - c) Schedule "C" Budget
  - d) Schedule "D" Payment Schedule
  - e) Schedule "E" Tariff-Fares

#### **SECTION 5 - MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**

- 5.1 <u>Amendment</u>: This Annual Operating Agreement and the Schedules attached hereto may be amended only with the prior written consent of all parties.
- 5.2 <u>Assignment</u>: This Annual Operating Agreement shall not be assignable without the prior written consent of the other parties.
- 5.3 <u>Enurement</u>: The Annual Operating Agreement shall be binding upon and enure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors.

**SECTION 6 - Notices and Communication** 

All notices, claims and communications required or permitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be sufficiently given if personally delivered to a responsible officer of the party hereto to whom it is addressed or if mailed by prepaid registered mail, to:

1) Payment Schedule

The Authority agrees to pay the Operating Company a monthly payment on the following basis:

- a) for Specified Service in Schedule "B":
  - for Fixed Monthly Payment; plus
  - ii) per Revenue Hour; plus
  - III) Variable distance costs for fuel and tires as billed, with satisfactory supporting documentation.
- b) for Maintenance:
  - Vehicle maintenance subcontracted by the Operating Company shall be paid at cost in accordance with the budget specified in Schedule "C", with satisfactory supporting documentation (invoices).
- c) Special Group Trips cost recovery shall be credited to the Authority on the monthly contractors invoice.
- d) BC Transit will cost share with the City a fee of \$4 for each Taxi Saver ride provided to a wheelchair or scooter user up to a maximum of \$1,000 per month.
