

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 6979

A Bylaw to amend the "City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993"

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal and Motor Vehicle Acts, Council has enacted "City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993" to regulate parking and traffic on highways within the City;

AND WHEREAS Council is now desirous of amending section **32. Police Vehicle Zones**, and **SCHEDULE "A" Class "B" Offenses** pertaining thereto, of said Bylaw to create designated parking spaces for ambulances and penalties for unauthorised use thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Section **32.**, **Police Vehicle Zones**, of "City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993" (as amended) is hereby repealed in its entirety.
2. A new Section **32.**, **Emergency Vehicle Zones** is substituted therefor as follows:

32. Emergency Vehicle Zones

a) **Police Vehicle Zones**

1. **Designation**

The Director, Public Works, is hereby authorised to establish police vehicle zones for the use of police vehicles.

2. **Regulation of Use**

When signs have been erected, no person shall park or stop a vehicle or permit a vehicle to remain parked or stopped in a police vehicle zone other than a police vehicle.

b) **Ambulance Vehicle Zones**

1. **Designation**

The Director, Public Works, is hereby authorised to establish ambulance vehicle zones for the use of ambulances of the British Columbia Ambulance Service.

2. Regulation of Use

When signs have been erected, no person shall park or stop a vehicle or permit a vehicle to remain parked or stopped in an ambulance vehicle zone other than an ambulance of the British Columbia Ambulance Service.

3. That SCHEDULE "A" - VOLUNTARY PAYMENT PENALTIES, Class "B" Offenses, of "City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993" (as amended), be, and is, hereby amended by deleting all references to an offence for "Park in Police Vehicle Zone" therein, and adding the following words and phrases contained in parenthesis thereto:

<u>Bylaw Section</u>	<u>Offence Description</u>
"32 a) 2."	"Park in Police Vehicle Zone"
"32 b) 2."	"Park in Ambulance Vehicle Zone".

4. This bylaw may be cited as "City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993, Amendment Bylaw No. 6979, 1998".


READ A FIRST TIME THIS THE 24th DAY OF AUGUST, 1998.
