

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 8154

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George authorizing the expenditure of monies from the Downtown Off-Street Parking Future Expenditure Reserve Fund for capital projects as per the year 2008 capital budget approved by Council.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Downtown Off-Street Parking Future Expenditure Reserve Fund established by "Downtown Off-Street Parking Future Expenditure Reserve By-Law No. 5232, 1988" of \$1,403,855, which is calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Bylaw No. 5232 for capital projects as per the year 2008 capital budget approved by Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The sum of \$80,000 is hereby appropriated from the Downtown Off-Street Parking Future Expenditure Reserve Fund to finance the following:

Community Services Department
-Parkade - Revitalization \$80,000

2. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Downtown Off-Street Parking Future Expenditure Reserve Fund.
3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Downtown Off-Street Parking Future Expenditure Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw No. 8154, 2008".


READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE **15th** DAY OF **DECEMBER , 2008.**
