CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 8289

A BYLAW TO TERMINATE A LOCAL AREA SERVICE ESTABLISHED UNDER "1973 SIDEWALK CANOPY CONSTRUCTION BYLAW NO. 2555, 1973".

WHEREAS Council has adopted "1973 Sidewalk Canopy Construction Bylaw No. 2555, 1973" establishing a local area service for the construction of sidewalk canopies;

AND WHEREAS Section 137 of the *Community Charter* provides that a bylaw must be repealed subject to the same approval and other requirements, if any, as the power to adopt a new bylaw under that authority,

AND WHEREAS "1973 Sidewalk Canopy Construction Bylaw No. 2555, 1973" was adopted after notice of intention to establish the local service was given by Council, together with an opportunity for property owners to petition against the establishment of the service, in accordance with the provisions of the *Municipal Act* then in effect:

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to terminate the local area service established by "1973 Sidewalk Canopy Construction Bylaw No. 2555, 1973" has been given in accordance with the provisions of the *Community Charter*,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. The local area service established pursuant to "1973 Sidewalk Canopy Construction Bylaw No. 2555, 1973" is hereby terminated.
- 2. "1973 Sidewalk Canopy Construction Bylaw No. 2555, 1973" is hereby repealed.
- 3. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on August 1, 2010.
- 4. This Bylaw may be cited as "Downtown Sidewalk Canopy Local Area Service Termination Bylaw No. 8289, 2010".
