

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE
BYLAW NO. 8402

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to amend "Prince George Heritage Commission Bylaw No. 8133, 2008".

WHEREAS, pursuant to Part 27 of the *Local Government Act*, Council established a Community Heritage Commission and set out the method of appointment of membership to the Commission, together with the composition, duties and procedures of the Commission;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Prince George has deemed it desirable to amend "Prince George Heritage Commission Bylaw No. 8133, 2008" to reduce the number of members and change the number of years of consecutive service on the commission.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That "Prince George Heritage Commission Bylaw No. 8133, 2008", be, and is, hereby amended by:
 - a) repealing the existing Section 2.1, and substituting it with the following:

"2.1 The Commission shall consist of not less than five (5) and not more than nine (9) members appointed from the Public at Large by the Council of the City of Prince George"; and
 - b) repealing the existing Section 2.4, and substituting it with the following:

"2.4 An individual may be appointed as a member of the Commission for a maximum of six (6) consecutive years of service."
2. The Mayor and Corporate Officer are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Prince George Heritage Commission Bylaw No. 8133, 2008, Amendment Bylaw No. 8402, 2012".
