

**CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE**  
**BYLAW NO. 8780**

**A Bylaw to amend the “City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993”.**

**WHEREAS** Council enacted “City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993”, to regulate parking and traffic on highways within the City of Prince George;

**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it desirable to amend the “City of Prince Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993”, by deleting and replacing text and repealing certain sections.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled,  
**ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That “City of Prince George Parking and Traffic Bylaw No. 6056, 1993”, be amended as follows:

**1. Definitions and Interpretation**

that the definition “Residential Permit” be added as follows:

“**Residential Permit**” means a permit issued by the City of Prince George to residents of neighbourhoods where there is an identified high demand for parking including neighbourhoods with schools, hospitals, or busy commercial areas.”

**2. Section 9. Maximum Parking Limit**

that Section “9.3. Parking Limitation On Adjacent Areas” be deleted and replaced with the following:

“**Parking Limitation On Adjacent Areas**

No person shall move a vehicle or permit a vehicle to be moved from one location to another in the same block or zone so that the cumulative or consecutive time parked in that block or zone exceeds the maximum parking time limit for that block or zone. <sup>1</sup>

1. Municipal, Provincial or Federal Government Vehicles. Commercial Vehicles and vehicles displaying a valid Residential Permit for the block or zone are exempt from this provision.

**3. Section 60. Physically Disabled Persons Parking Permit**

that Section “60.2. c.), d.), and e.)” be deleted and the Section renumbered accordingly.

#### 4. Section 66. Penalties

that Section "66. Penalties" be deleted and replaced with the following:

##### **"66. Penalties**

##### **1. This Bylaw may be enforced,**

- (a) by means of a Municipal Ticket Information authorized under section 264 of the *Community Charter*; or
- (b) by an Information laid in accordance with the *Offence Act*.

##### **2. With respect to enforcement by means of a Municipal Ticket Information under section 264 of the *Community Charter*, the fines outlined in Schedule "A", attached to and forming part of this Bylaw, shall apply.**

- (a) Pursuant to section 264(1) of the *Community Charter*, the Bylaw section number appearing in Column 1 of Schedule "A" to this Bylaw designate the offence committed under the Bylaw and Column 2 opposite the section number indicates the respective words or expression.
- (b) Pursuant to section 265(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, the fine amount in Column 3 of Schedule "A" to this Bylaw is the fine amount that corresponds to the section number and words or expression set out in Columns 1 and 2 opposite the fine amount.
- (c) Council delegates its duty to refer any disputed tickets to the Provincial Court for a hearing to a Bylaw Enforcement Officer and to the RCMP.

##### **3. Every person who contravenes a provision of this bylaw to which information laid in accordance with the *Offence Act*, shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$10,000.00 and costs of prosecution.**

##### **4. Any person who contravenes any section of this Bylaw for which a penalty is provided by the *Motor Vehicle Act* is guilty of an offence and on conviction is subject to penalties provided therefor in the *Motor Vehicle Act*."**

#### 5. Section 67. Parking Infraction Notice

that Section "67. Parking Infraction Notice" be amended by deleting the words "as detailed in Schedule "E"" and inserting "1. The penalty on Parking Infraction Notice shall be the penalty as designated for each specific offence in Schedule "A" of this Bylaw." immediately following the words "operator of such motor vehicle."

#### 6. Section 69. Voluntary Payment of Parking Penalties

that Section "69.1 Voluntary Payment of Parking Penalties" be amended by deleting the words "ten (10) days (exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays)" and replacing it with the words "twenty-one 21 days (inclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays)"

7. that Schedule "A" be deleted and replaced with the following:
