

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7762

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George authorizing the expenditure of monies from the Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure for capital projects as per the year 2005 capital budget approved by Council.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure established by: "Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure Bylaw No. 6935, 1998" of \$3 813 602.

Balance in Reserve Fund at December 31, 2004 \$3 813 602

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Bylaw No. 6935 for capital projects as per the year 2005 capital budget approved by Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The sum of \$1 138 000 is hereby appropriated from the Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure to finance the following:

Development Services Department

-Hydrant Replacement Program	\$10 000
-Mainline Valve Replacement	50 000
-Municipal Infrastructure Management System (MIMS)	60 000
-National Research Council (NRC) Participation Fee	18 000
-Pressure Zone Investigation	25 000
-PW606 – Decommissioning	150 000
-PW611 – Twinning	175 000
-Service Replacement Program – Water	200 000
-Water Conservation Plan	100 000
-Water Pumpstation Capital Upgrades	200 000
-Well Protection & Decommissioning Program	150 000

Total \$1 138 000

2. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure.
3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Water Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure Bylaw No. 7762, 2005".
