

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE
BYLAW NO. 7776

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to amend the Water Regulation and Rates Bylaw No. 7479, 2003.

WHEREAS Bylaw No. 7479 was enacted to operate and regulate the waterworks service and the provision of water in the Municipality, and to impose connection fees, water rates, and charges for use of waterworks and to encourage the conservation of water;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend the "Water Regulation and Rates Bylaw No. 7479, 2003" by adding text to the aforementioned bylaw to facilitate volume-based pricing of water metered residential customers.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the "Water Regulation and Rates Bylaw No. 7479, 2003" be amended by adding the following additional text and forming part of this Bylaw:
 - a) Section 8.1 - Installation of Meters, following Subsection 8.1.1, as follows:
 - 8.1.2 According to the Water Conservation Plan and notwithstanding any other provision of this Bylaw, any person who is the owner of a Single Family Dwelling or Duplex or Residential Strata Lot is eligible to volunteer to have a meter installed on their water service if approved by the Authorized Person. The owner of the property receiving the meter also thereby agrees to provide all applicable information to the Authorized Person.
 - b) Section 8.2 - Meter Size and Supply, following Subsection 8.2.1, as follows:
 - 8.2.2 Notwithstanding Section 8.2.1 of this Bylaw, where a person is the owner of Single Family Dwelling or Duplex or Residential Strata Lot, and has volunteered to have a meter installed, and has obtained approval from the Authorized Person, the meter, remote reading equipment and strainer shall be provided by the City for installation by the City and shall remain the property of the City. The meter, remote reading equipment and strainer shall remain on the water connection for residential customers except in cases of when any the water service is to be abandoned according to Section 6.4.1 of this Bylaw.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Water Regulation and Rates Bylaw No. 7479, 2003, Amendment Bylaw No. 7776, 2005".

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE 12th DAY OF September , 2005.


READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 12th DAY OF September , 2005.
