

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7630

A Bylaw to amend the “Records Administration Bylaw No. 6277, 1994”, by removing the fees and charges therein and placing them in the Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw.

WHEREAS Council enacted the “Records Administration Bylaw No. 6277, 1994”, to establish procedures for the administration of municipal records and the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, and to prescribe a schedule of maximum fees for routinely available records;

AND WHEREAS Council wishes to amend Bylaw 6277 by removing the fees and charges levied therein and placing those fees and charges in the “City of Prince George Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 7557, 2004”;

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Schedules “A” and “D” are hereby removed in their entirety and placed in the “City of Prince George Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 7557, 2004” as Schedule “C-3(a)” and “C-3(b)” respectively;
2. That Section 3.1 is hereby amended by removing the words “in Schedule “A” attached hereto.” and replacing them with the words “in Schedule “C-3(a)” of the “City of Prince George Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 7557, 2004”.”
3. That Section 3.3 is hereby amended by removing the words “in Schedule “D” (attached hereto as Appendix “A”)” and replacing them with the words “in Schedule “C-3(b)” of the “City of Prince George Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 7557, 2004”.”
4. That, “Records Administration Bylaw 6277, 1994, Amendment Bylaw No. 7413, 2002” and “Records Administration Bylaw 6277, 1994, Amendment Bylaw No. 7470, 2003” are hereby repealed in their entirety.
5. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
6. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “Records Administration Bylaw No. 6277, 1994, Amendment Bylaw No. 7630, 2004”.
