

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7466

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to stop up and close to traffic a portion of Stevenson Road. With the intent to sell the property to the adjoining landowners, David and Susan Stevenson.

WHEREAS the City of Prince George has been requested under the Delegation of Power Bylaw No. 7388, that City Administration approve the sale of a 490 sq ft portion of unconstructed highway situated directly north of Lot 1, Block 49, District Lot 343, Cariboo District, Plan 1268, (101 Burden Street) for the sum of \$1.00, shown in heavy black outline on the attached Schedule A.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Prince George has deemed it desirable that said road be stopped up and closed to traffic;

AND WHEREAS an opportunity has been provided for persons who consider they are affected by the Bylaw to make representation to Council;

AND WHEREAS the City of Prince George intends to Petition the Minister of Community, Aboriginal, and Women's Services to vest title of the aforesaid closed road in the name of the City, for subsequent sale and transfer to the owner (land known as directly north of Lot 1, Block 49, District Lot 343, Cariboo District, Plan 1268 (101 Burden Street));

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the portion of unconstructed highway situated directly North of Lot 1, Block 49, District Lot 343, Cariboo District, Plan 1268, (101 Burden Street), shown in heavy black outline on the attached Schedule "A", is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
2. The Mayor and Clerk of the City of Prince George are hereby authorized to Petition the Minister of Community, Aboriginal, and Women's Services to vest title of the aforesaid closed road in the name of the City for subsequent sale and transfer to the owners of the portion of unconstructed highway situated directly North of Lot 1, Block 49, District Lot 343, Cariboo District, Plan 1268, (101 Burden Street).
3. Prior to adoption, this Bylaw shall be advertised once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper circulating in the municipality.
4. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.

5. This Bylaw shall come into full force and take effect upon its adoption and shall be filed in the Prince George Land Title Office.
6. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Stevenson Road Closure Bylaw No. 7466, 2003".


READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 17th DAY OF March, 2003.

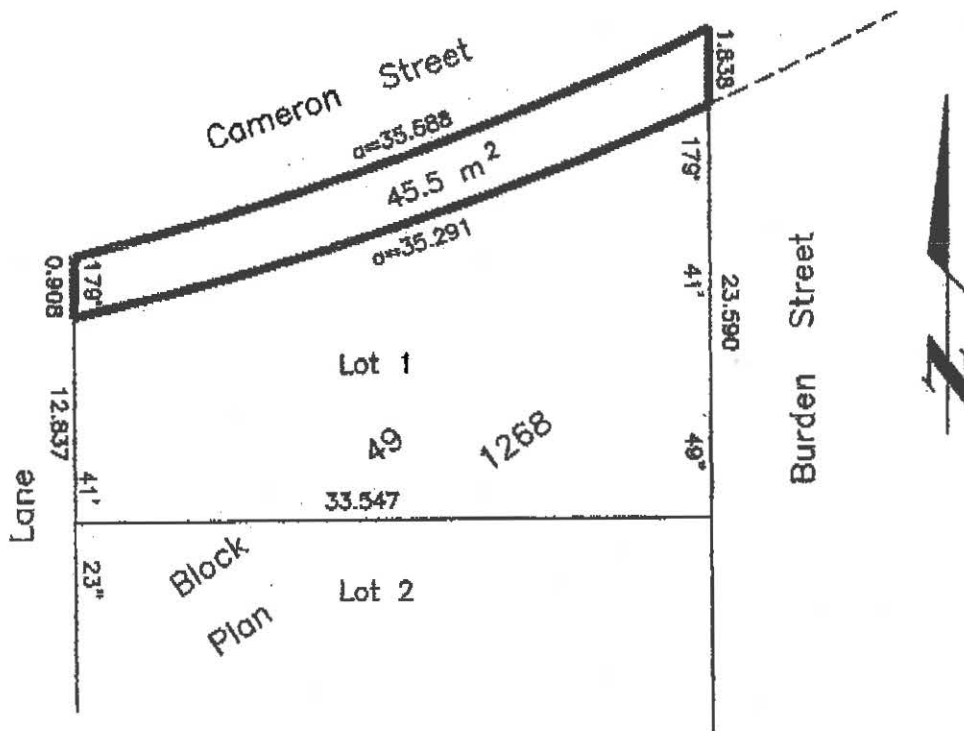
