

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE
BYLAW NO. 7936

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George authorizing the expenditure of monies from the Core Water Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund for capital projects as per the year 2006 capital budget approved by Council.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Core Water Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund established by "Core Water Development Cost Charge Reserve Bylaw No. 6882, 1998" of \$763 349, which amount has been calculated as follows:

Balance in Reserve Fund at December 31, 2005	\$597 269
Add: DCC Revenues	<u>166 080</u>
Balance in Reserve Fund	<u>\$763 349</u>

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Bylaw No. 6882 for capital projects as per the year 2006 capital budget approved by Council.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The sum of \$635 000 is hereby appropriated from the Core Water Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund to finance the following:

Development Services Department

-BCR / Danson Water Supply	\$85 000
-Watermain Extension – River Road	15 000
-Watermain Looping	35 000
-Watermain PW805 to Ferry Ave	<u>500 000</u>
Total	<u>\$635 000</u>

2. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Core Water Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund.
3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Core Water Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw No. 7936, 2006".


READ A FIRST TIME THIS THE **18th** DAY OF **DECEMBER** , 2006.


READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE **18th** DAY OF **DECEMBER** , 2006.
