

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 8152

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George authorizing the expenditure of monies from the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund for capital projects as per the year 2008 capital budget approved by Council.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund established by "Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 7179, 2000" of \$770,327 which is calculated as follows:

Balance in Reserve Fund at December 31, 2007	\$1,036,635
Less: 2007 Carry forwards – Capital	745,000
2007 Carry forwards – Operating	356,308
Add: Bylaw 8146 – Transfer from Capital Exp Reserve Fund	835,000
Balance in the Reserve	<u>\$770,327</u>

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Bylaw No. 7179 for capital projects as per the year 2008 capital budget approved by Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The sum of \$655,000 is hereby appropriated from the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund to finance the following:

Corporate Services Department

-Computer Hardware/Software

\$655,000

2. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund.
3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw No. 8152, 2008".


READ A FIRST TIME THIS THE **15th** DAY OF **DECEMBER, 2008.**
