

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7676

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George authorizing the expenditure of monies from the Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure for capital projects as per the year 2004 capital budget approved by Council.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure established by "Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure Bylaw No. 6933, 1998" of \$4 600 486.

Balance in Reserve Fund at December 31, 2003 \$4 600 486

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Bylaw No. 6933 for capital projects as per the year 2004 capital budget approved by Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The sum of \$1 115 000 is hereby appropriated from the Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure to finance the following:

2. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure.

3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Core Sewer Utility Reserve for Future Expenditure Bylaw No. 7676, 2004".
