

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7665

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to authorize the appropriation of monies from the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund to General Operating Revenue to fund lease finance purchase payments for computer hardware and software, as per the year 2004 capital budget approved by Council.

WHEREAS, the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund has been established by "Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 7179, 2000";

AND WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund of \$1 397 577, which has been calculated as follows:

Balance in Reserve Fund at December 31, 2003	\$897 577
Add: Bylaw 7664 – Transfer from Capital Expenditure Reserve	<u>\$500 000</u>
Balance in the Reserve Fund	<u>\$1 397 577</u>

AND WHEREAS "Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 7179, 2000" stipulates that monies in the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund may be used for the purchase of computer hardware and software including periodic payments that are required as a result of using the lease financing purchase option to acquire the hardware and software;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The sum of \$331 000 is hereby transferred from the Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund to General Operating Revenue to fund lease finance purchase payments for computer hardware and software, as per the year 2004 capital budget approved by Council.
2. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund.
3. This bylaw may be cited as "Computer Hardware and Software Reserve Fund Transfer Bylaw No. 7665, 2004".
