

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE
BYLAW NO. 8250

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to amend "Records Administration Bylaw No. 6277, 1994".

WHEREAS Council enacted "Records Administration Bylaw No. 6277, 1994" to establish procedures for the administration of municipal records and the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, and to prescribe a schedule of maximum fees for routinely available records;

AND WHEREAS Council desires an amendment for Bylaw No. 6277, 1994 to remove the reference to procedures and fees regarding the provision of digital mapping data and products due to the electronic availability of the digital mapping information via a City of Prince George web site.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That "Records Administration Bylaw No. 6277, 1994" is hereby amended as follows and forming part of the bylaw:
 - a) by deleting Section 3.3 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

"3.3 Digital Mapping Data

 - (a) Notwithstanding section 3.1, no fees shall be payable by an applicant to obtain access to digital mapping data which is designated as being routinely available to the public.
 - (b) Applicants requesting access to digital mapping data pursuant to this Bylaw shall be required to enter into a licence agreement with the City of Prince George in such form that is approved by the Director of Corporate Services from time to time."
 - b) by deleting Schedule "E" – License Agreement;
 - c) by deleting Schedule "F" – Digital Map Products Request; and
 - d) by deleting Schedule "G" – Procedure For Distribution of Digital Mapping Data.
2. That the Mayor and Corporate Officer are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this bylaw.

3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "City of Prince George Records Administration Bylaw No. 6277, 1994, Amendment Bylaw No. 8250, 2009".


READ A FIRST TIME THIS THE 16th DAY OF NOVEMBER , 2009.
