

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7417

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George to stop up and close to traffic a portion of Lear Road at Highway 16 East adjacent to Lots 44, 45, 46, 47 and 48, Block 20, District Lot 629, Cariboo District, Plan 902.

WHEREAS the City of Prince George has been requested to stop up and close to traffic a portion of road adjacent to Lots 44, 45, 46, 47 and 48, Block 20, District Lot 629, Cariboo District, Plan 902;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Prince George has deemed it desirable that said road be stopped up and closed to traffic;

AND WHEREAS an opportunity has been provided for persons who consider they are affected by the Bylaw to make representations to Council;

AND WHEREAS the City of Prince George intends to Petition the Minister of Community, Aboriginal, and Women's Services to vest title of the aforesaid closed road in the name of the City, for subsequent sale and transfer to the owner of land east of the closed road (land known as Lots 44, 45, 46, 47 and 48, Block 20, District Lot 629, Cariboo District, Plan 902);

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That portion of road adjacent to Lots 44, 45, 46, 47, and 48, Block 20, District Lot 629, Cariboo District, Plan 902, as shown outlined in heavy black line on the map attached to, and forming part of, this Bylaw as Appendix "A", is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
2. The Mayor and Clerk of the City of Prince George are hereby authorized to Petition the Minister of Community, Aboriginal, and Women's Services to vest title of the aforesaid closed road in the name of the City for subsequent sale and transfer to the owners of the land adjoining the closed road (land known as Lots 44, 45, 46, 47 and 48, Block 20, District Lot 629, Cariboo District, Plan 902).
3. Prior to adoption, this Bylaw shall be advertised once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper circulating in the municipality.
4. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby empowered to do all things necessary to give effect to this Bylaw.
5. This Bylaw shall come into full force and take effect upon its adoption and shall be filed in the Prince George Land Title Office.

6. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Lear Road at Highway 16 East Road Closure Bylaw No. 7417, 2002".

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE 29th DAY OF JULY, 2002.

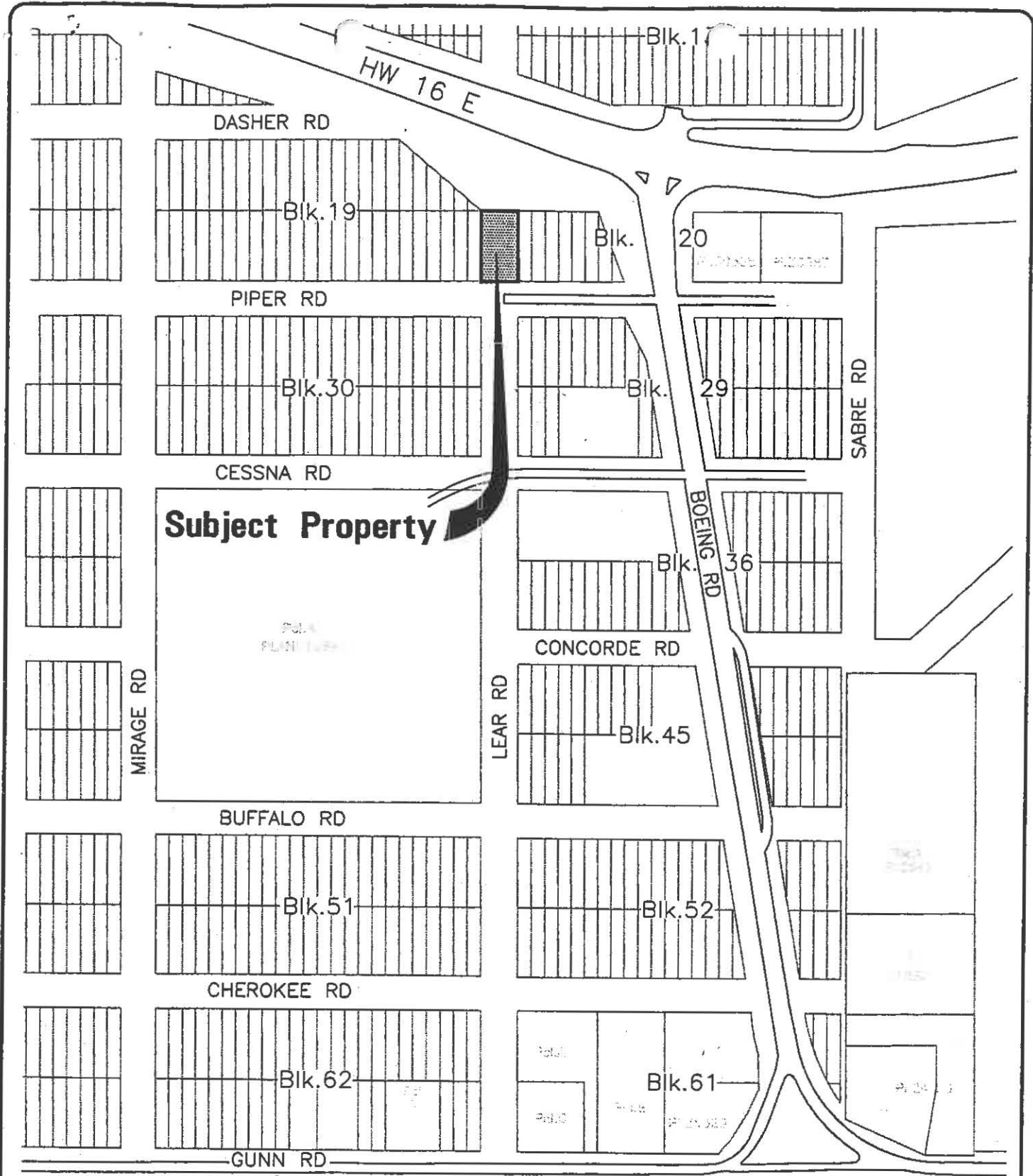
READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE 29th DAY OF JULY, 2002.
